



MESSAGE FROM OUR DIRECTOR

This year, Tru Vista Foundation was focused on finding greater stability and increasing our influence. We worked to serve our current contracts, find new funding sources and widen the scope services we provide.

Our Safe Babies Court case load grew this year, while Family Treatment Court declined and is expected to cease. We are shifting our focus from almost entirely reunification services to a greater emphasis on Family Stability and Preservation cases. Having a long history of working with the courts, we find many clients will reach out months or years later to our Parent Partners to request assistance when dealing with a crisis or a new phase of life. We are seeking more of this work to prevent re-removal and minimize involvement with Human Services Agency.

We are also building a national presence as our main Parent Partner, Crystal Hallock, serves as a Parent Leader with Zero-to-Three, the national organization supporting Infant and Toddler Court Programs. Other jurisdictions seek her advice on hiring and training Peer Mentors to increase the supports to their clients. She also received a new certification as a PRSS Supervisor, giving her a more official capacity to train, mentor and supervise other staff. My goal is to receive the same certification as soon as it is offered on a non-peer track.

In 2022-23, we hope to see more of our court hearings in-person, where Tru Vista can host clients in our

office before and after hearings to increase engagement, offer mentorship and build community.
